Dear Sculptors Society Members,

An invitation to all members, working with wood/metal/stone to participate in Australia's National Farm Sculpture Award 2009. It has a first prize of \$10,000 and secondary prizes of \$5,000. The Award is hosted by Spirit of the Land Lockhart NSW which last year attracted media crews from UK, Brazil, NZ, German and China and was broadcast to some 14 countries in five languages. The Award sponsors were Origin Energy, Bilfinger Berger and Siemen's Ltd: all multinational corporations aware of the impact of drought on rural communities and escalating concerns over rural suicide. Farm sculpture is defined as sculptures created from recycled or new farm materials and/or any natural element of the land. Artists may register interest online at the end of this month.

The Festival runs over three days from 9 - 12th October 2009 and incorporates the Fine Arts, Performing arts and Edible arts. In addition to the National Award, there are also major corporate acquisition sponsors and the festival culminates in an auction of exhibits. Sculptures for display only would need to be discussed.
