CULTURAL GRANTS PROGRAM 2010/2011

NOW OPEN!

The Cultural Grants Program for 2010/2011 is open from 1 February to 30 April 2010.

Wollongong City Council makes funds available under its Cultural Grants Program to individuals and non-profit organisations to support projects that increase participation in the arts and culture. A range of projects are eligible such as performing arts, visual arts, crafts, literature and activities which reflect local cultural heritage. All applicants must be based in the Wollongong LGA. Artists and communities who are Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (C.A.L.D.) and Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islanders are encouraged to apply. This year's Cultural Grant Program is linked to a performance component in the Viva La Gong Festival.

Category 1 – Community Cultural Development - Projects

This category supports local arts based Community Cultural Development projects devised and driven by individual artists and communities in the City of Wollongong. Applicants can request up to \$2000.

Category 2 – Professional Development, Marketing and Minor Capital Infrastructure Support

This category provides support for local arts organisations, groups and cultural initiatives with a community focus for professional development, marketing and minor infrastructure support. Applicants can request up to \$4000.

This highly successful festival is now in its 20th year and involves several art components as well as entertainment and activities celebrating our local artists and community. The main activities revolve around the main street on the Saturday and the Beachside park on the Sunday.

Sat Art Seen is one of the art componts of the festival program. As the title implies, Sat Art Seen has about 20 artists spread throughout the main street of Thirroul on the Saturday of the festival. These artists are involved in art-in-progress so that the public may be exposed to the unique experience of seeing artists at work and being able to chat and ask questions and hopefully purchase some art works or make arrangements to follow up in the future.

This event is a way of promoting artists and their work. You will be able to display and sell your work with no commission to the festival as we appreciate the contribution you are making to the overall art experience. It can be a fun day and enjoyable *experience* for both artists and the interested public.

It is planned that artists set up from 10.30am to 3.30pm.

Artists will be allocated an exact location and are required to provide their own equipment and gear ie table and chairs, easels, ground sheet if painting etc.

Volunteers will circulate and mind your spot for a toilet break.

It is also strongly advised that you bring a sunhat, sun screen and water. Some shade will be provided but you may prefer your own umbrella or gazebo to ensure maximum conditions.
