But **nobody** realised that **nobody** would do it.

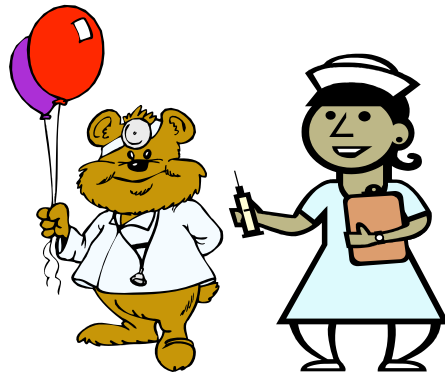
So it ended up that **Everybody** blamed **Somebody**
