STOP PRESS! Project Contemporary Artspace is excited to announce that the gallery is in the process of signing a 5-year lease for its current location at 255 Keira Street in Wollongong. This is great news for Project and local artists, and will take Project to 10 years of existence on the edge of the CBD and shopping district. This news comes on top of a Cultural Grant for Project to install a new gallery wall and small exhibition space, as well as new signage for the front of the gallery, and fliers to promote Project. Project would like to thank Wollongong City Council for its ongoing commitment and support.

Urgent Call for Submissions – 2010 Exhibitions
the deadline is just 4 weeks away ...

new deadline: 5pm, Tuesday 17 November 2009

Project Contemporary Artspace is calling for exhibition proposals for 2010. With the gallery's long-term future secured and a new look on the way, now is the perfect time to exhibit at Project! Project is particularly looking for artists who wish to exhibit January-March, with payment deadlines able to be negotiated. In 2010, Project will have TWO exhibition spaces available for hire:

1. Main Space: Project's main gallery space includes approx. 54 lineal metres of wall space (including two moveable walls), with a track and wire hanging system, as well as a large floor space. Perfect for small or large group shows, or major solo exhibitions.

2. Small Wall: this is Project's new exhibition space, a white wall measuring 4.2m wide x 3.9m high, including a track and wire hanging system across the top, as well as the floor space immediately in front of the wall. This new space is suitable for video or multimedia pieces, installation pieces, a large work or a number of small works, and is perfect for artists who do not wish to hire the

main exhibition space but want to show some of their work. Exhibitions using this new space will run in sync with exhibitions in the main space.

The Small Wall has been made possible thanks to a Cultural Grant from Community, Cultural & Library Services, Wollongong City Council.

Notice for members who have requested that their details not be published

In the notice that went out requesting members register their information that they want published on the ican website, it clearly stated that if you had already requested your details not to be published you did not have to do anything at all.

Please do not send me anymore notes or letters reminding me of this. Your membership details on the ican database is noted 'NFP' (not for publication). For this status to be altered you will need to put the proposed changes in writing so until that happens the committee does not have permission to publish any of your information.

Notice for members who have sent in their information to be published on the ican website

This process will not begin until after the end of August when all the information is collected.

You will be required to sign the newly developed 'image reproduction licence for ican website' agreement to give ican permission to publish your images. Members and ican will each have a signed copy of the agreement. If your images are already on the ican website, as the trial website set up you will also be requested to sign this agreement. Changes can be made to existing images and text at the discretion of the web designer (Bettina).

This project will end at the end of November 2009.

Notice for those who had pictures of works taken at Clifton school of arts

This information is stored on the ican lap top.

The first lot are all filed and on the CD that you received after the project.

For the second lot (last year), the files have not all been labelled with the title of the work and the title of the artist etc.

This is a big job.

As the funding was cut in half for this project this is one job that has not been done.

I think I know which member owns which work.

I will copy these files onto CD and give them to you.

You will then be able to choose which files you want to send to Bettina, have them suitable labelled and emailed to Bettina.

If you **do not have a computer or email access**, please ask someone in your family or friends to look at the files with you and you pick the ones that will be most suitable and note their file number.

New members who have joined ican after June 2009.

I have copies of the information and the form to be filled in so that you can have your own web page. There is no charge for this.

If you email me it will send the form back in a reply email. If you get it in quickly your details will be accepted.

If you do not have email please ring me on 4267 2697 leaving your details or just your name and one will be sent out in your 'ican do it' newsletter.

This project will end at the end of November 2009.

By this date Bettina will have entered the contact details, images, and text.
Then the acquittal document will be then sent to Cultural Services of Wollongong City Council.
This project was to have been acquitted in May 2009, so we are keen to get it all finished up.
